Daylight Savings Time?

March 13, 2011 - Many people in North America and the use the term “spring forward” and “fall back” when they refer to the daylight saving start and end dates. This is because of the fact that DST occurs in the spring season and ends in the fall in the northern hemisphere, where Canada, the UK, and the United States (USA) are located.

History of Daylight Saving Time

Daylight saving time (DST) is a change in the standard time with the purpose of getting better use of the daylight by having the sun rise one hour later in the morning and set one hour later in the evening. Although it has only been used in the past hundred years, the idea of DST was first conceived many years before.

Why Observe DST?

Many countries observe DST, and many do not. The reason many countries implement DST is in hopes to make better use of the daylight in the evenings, as well as some believe that it could be linked to reducing the amount of road accidents and injuries. The extra hour of daylight in the evening is said to give children more social time with friends and family and can even boost the tourism industry because it increases the amount of outdoor activities.

DST is also considered as a means to save energy due to less artificial light needed during the evening hours—clocks are set one hour ahead during the spring, and one hour back to standard time in the autumn. However, many studies disagree about the energy savings of DST.

It is difficult to predict what will happen with Daylight Saving Time in the future. The daylight saving date in many countries may change from time to time due to special events or conditions. The United States, Canada and some other countries extended DST in 2007. The new start date is the second Sunday in March (previously the first Sunday in April) through to the first Sunday in November (previously the last Sunday in October).


The Penguins Cave

LINUX - ANDROID

Welcome again to the Penguins Cave: Hi! And welcome again my dear readers, hoping you enjoy this column about Linux that is my passion. Finally after many years of the Linux operating system being behind the scenes running silently in servers, cable boxes, bar gaming machines, embedded systems for the industry, and of course home units running by geeks and the computer savvy. Linux in the actuality has become a more and more user friendly operating system being used now by non-geeks, all of this is possible by the effort of developers around the world, whose continuous upgrading, debugging, and development of the software.

Linux was invented in 1991 by Linus Torvalds (Finland student of the Helsinki University), writing his own kernel from Minix: a non commercial Unix-like operating system. This linux kernel was combined with the GNU project, and the Linux free operating system was born. GNU stands for "GNU's Not Unix" created by Richard Stallman, American software freedom activist and computer programmer. There are over 500 distributions (called distros for short) world wide, large and small, specialized and generalized, old and new. One of the most successful open source software projects, is Android, a mobile device platform built on the Linux Kernel version 2.6. created by Google and The Open Handset Alliance, a consortium of several companies which include Texas Instruments, Broadcom Corporation, Google, HTC, Intel, LG, Marvell Technology Group, Motorola, Nvidia, Qualcomm, Samsung Electronics, Sprint Nextel and T-Mobile. The goal of the Open Handset Alliance is to develop open standards for mobile devices. As I said my dear readers Linux is up now, it's in your cellphone, Tablet PC, Livingroom (TV, Cablebox, Blu-ray player, streaming Box, etc.) running the Linux core in "Android Operating System". Bye! and enjoy your Android device.

The Recipe Place

Chicken Fried Chicken

INGREDIENTS:

1 egg
1/4 cup veg. oil
30 saltine crackers
1 teaspoon seasoned salt
2 tablespoons all-purpose flour
2 tablespoons dry potato flakes
1/2 teaspoon ground black pepper
6 skinless, boneless chicken breast halves

PREP TIME..... 15 Min
COOK TIME..... 30 Min

"A fun chicken recipe the kids can help prepare. They love crushing the crackers. It does not matter if the measurements aren't perfect, just wing it!"

DIRECTIONS

1. Place crackers in a large resealable plastic bag; seal bag and crush crackers until they are coarse crumbs. Add flour, potato flakes, seasoned salt, and pepper to bag and mix well.
2. Beat egg in a shallow dish or bowl; heat oil in a large skillet over medium high heat.
3. One by one, dredge chicken pieces in egg beat, then place in bag with crumb mixture, seal bag and shake to coat.
4. Reduce heat to medium and cook coated chicken in skillet for 15 to 20 minutes, turning frequently, until golden brown and juices run clear.


